Overview	To develop a general understanding of the management philosophy known as asset management and the benefits and current limitations of this approach, together with the introduction of the MACRO concepts.
Objective	On successful completion of this 2-day course, students will be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Explain what is AM (including the benefits and limitations and in general terms how it is implemented).• Produce a definition of AM and be able to identify the key elements of the MACRO Project.
Content	The key contents of the course will cover the following topics: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Identify the motives for adopting asset management• MACRO Project partners and objectives• Cost/risk evaluations and trade offs• Analysis process• Decision support tools
Benefit	The course will benefit engineers, managers, operators, maintenance personnel and anyone who is involved in justifying maintenance expenditure, setting maintenance strategy, or who wishes to improve the auditable basis for their day-to-day decision-making.
Audience	The course is applicable to senior managers/team leaders/engineers and operators.
Pre-requisites	Although no pre-qualification is required, a degree-level or HND qualification is recommended.
